IMPROVISATION WITH RYAN HUBAN

Improvisation is the art of spontaneous group story-building. Ryan Huban will introduce essential improv techniques that will give you a solid foundation to perform spontaneous scenes on the spot. This workshop focuses on the importance of agreement, support, and group mind on stage. Practice being an active listener and learn to embrace spontaneity to create interesting characters and unique environments with your scene partners. These exercises and short-form games will get you moving, thinking quickly and, of course, laughing!

Ryan has studied improv comedy at The Upright Citizens Brigade Theater, The Magnet Theater, and Armando Diaz Studios. He has appeared on stage as a stand-up comic and performed in countless improv shows over the years, with groups that include “Out of Order” at Dover Little Theater, “Flea Flurkus” at The Magnet, and currently “Fury” at The PIT. Ryan founded Pratt Institute’s comedy club, “Up Top Playerz,” where he taught improvisation and produced and directed comedic plays. Before all this, Ryan used to be involved with community theater, but he kept changing his character’s lines to make them funnier. Improv has satiated Ryan’s discord with playwrights.
